On-campus Accommodation

Students have two options for on-campus accommodation: Miramar, the recommended housing for first year students, and Momentum Village, which offers apartment and townhome floor plans. Both offer outstanding value with all-inclusive rent, quick and easy access to the Island and Momentum Campus, Secure facilities and UPS are available 24/7, and residents generally have higher GPAs and are more involved in organizations when living on campus.

Campus Facilities

TAMU-CC has State-of-the-art facilities that promote great work as well as relaxing downtime, including:

- **Dugan Wellness Center:** Indoor facility with two NCAA-sized basketball courts, two multipurpose rooms for group fitness and Sports Clubs, and two floors of workout equipment including free weights and cardio equipment.

- **Momentum Multipurpose Fields:** These fields can be configured to accommodate a number of sports and events, including flag football, soccer, intramural contests, sports club practices, and games.
- **Hike and Bike Trail:** The trail was designed to be enjoyed by both fitness enthusiasts and nature explorers. The lighted trail is an excellent location to walk, bike, rollerblade or jog while taking in the splendor of Ward Island. The trail is for everyone, including our wildlife.
- **Campus Shuttle Service.**
- **Campus Dining:** 17 dining facilities with a wide array of cuisines to choose from.

Prepare for your bachelor's degree with other international students and join your chosen degree once you successfully complete the program.

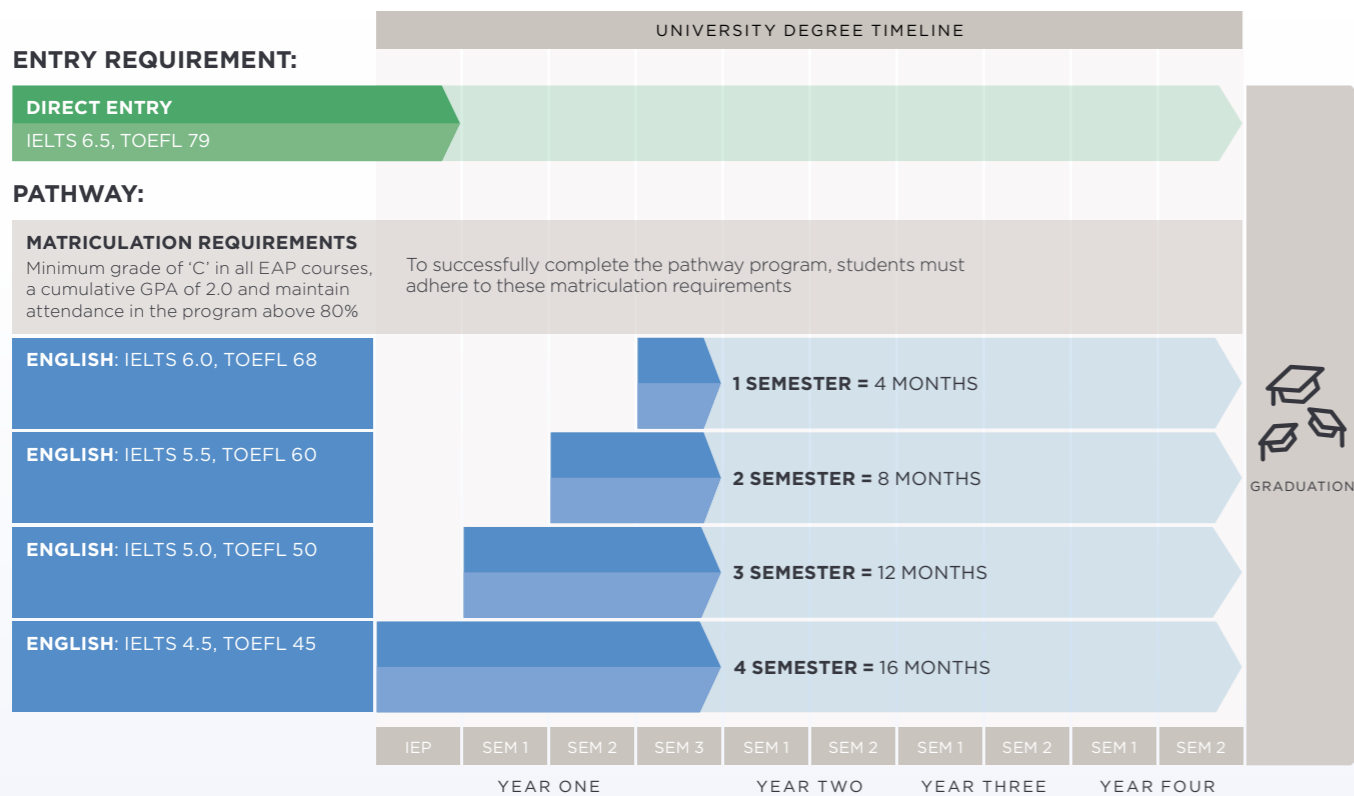
International Year

Advantages for undergraduates at the International Study Center.

- Graduate within four years*.
 - After completing your International Year at the International Study Center, you will move seamlessly into your degree program.
 - Depending on your pathway program, you may earn up to 24 credits towards your degree.
 - Save money by studying at the International Study Center first, as you study both English and academic courses.
 - You will take cohort classes with other international students in the International Study Center, receiving dedicated attention and academic help.
 - You will take regular classes with American students once you finish your pathway program and progress to full-time degree study at the University.
- *Graduation within 4 years is contingent upon student completing requisite number of credits, and may require a higher credit load in some semesters or attendance of summer term courses.

Pre-Master's Program

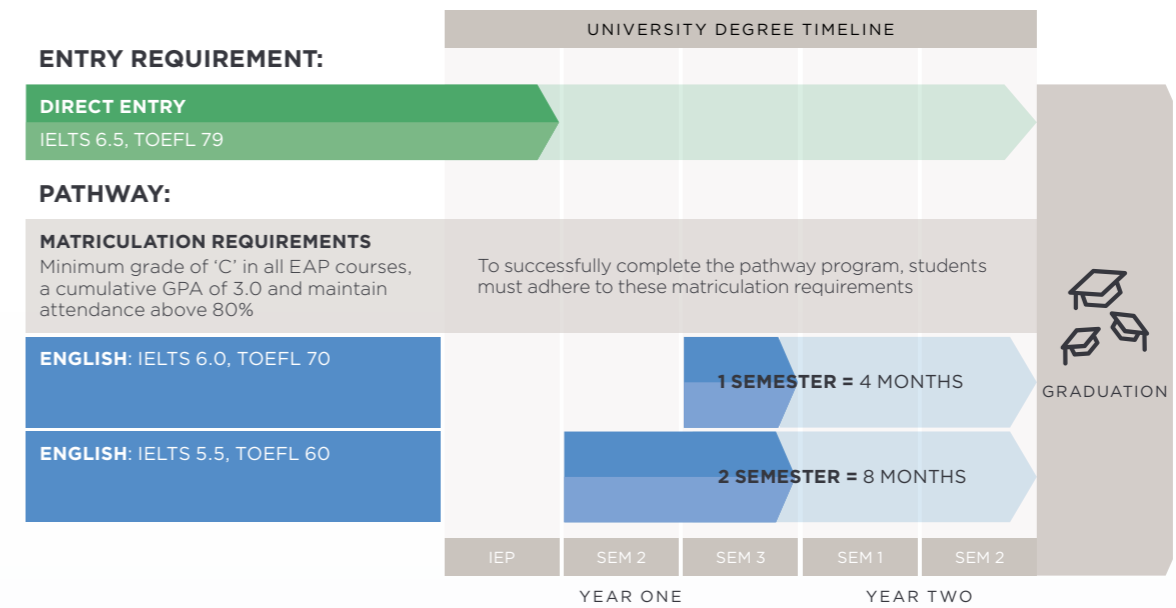
The Pre-Master's Program prepares you to make a strong start in your Master's degree, confident in your English speaking ability. Work with experienced and respected faculty and discover your potential

within your field, either in research or in the workplace. Depending on your chosen master's degree and academic background, you can take up to four academic courses during the Pre-Master's Program, saving you time and money.

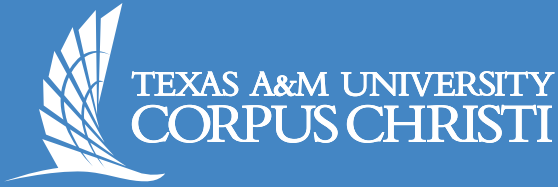
